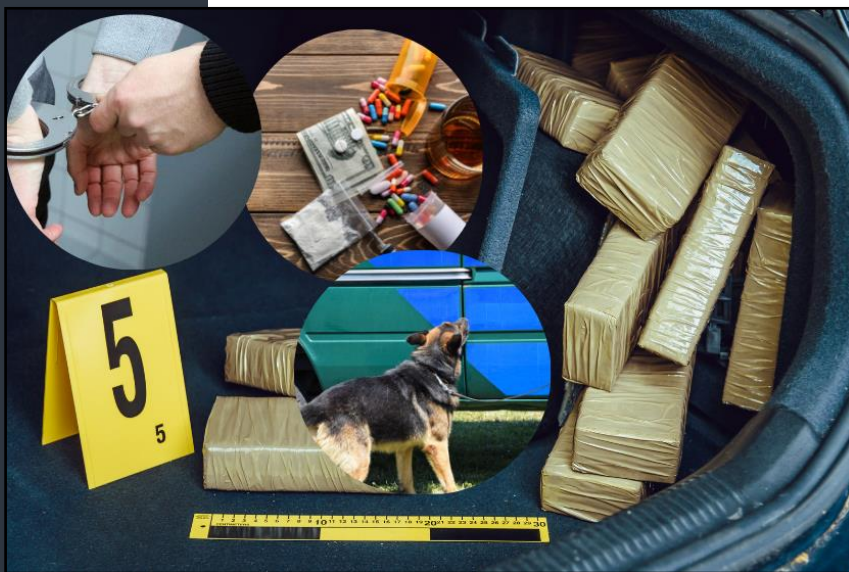
This class covers:
